**Directions:** From exit 41 on I-95, take Rt. 175 West to Columbia Gateway Drive and turn left. The inner loop of the circuit will be closed to traffic so continue along the road until you arrive at Albert Einstein Drive, where there will be a marshal who will direct you to park.

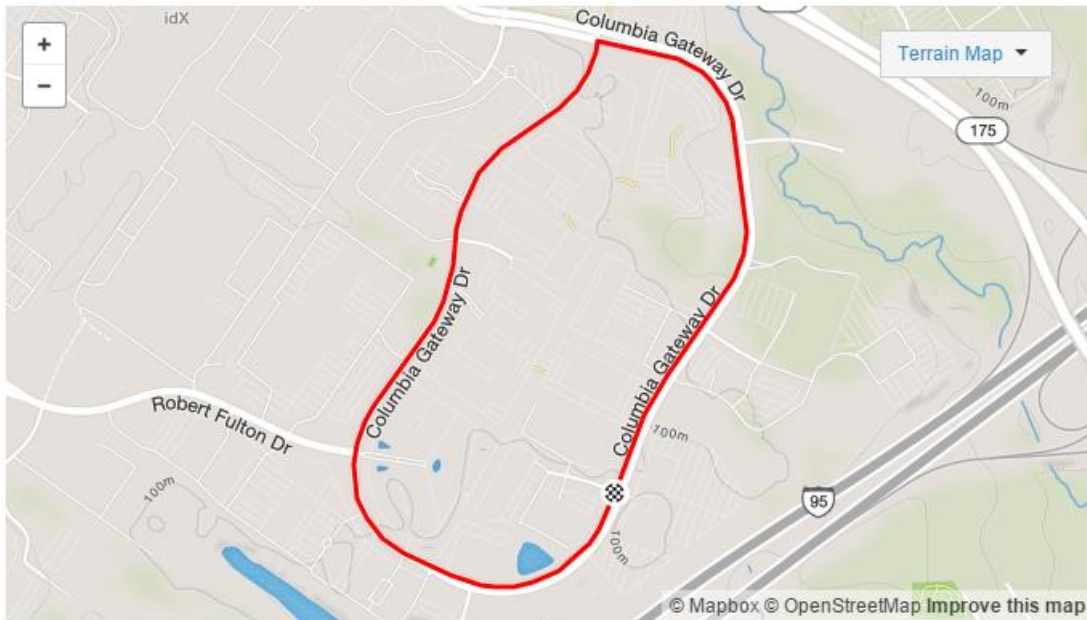
**Course:** The course is a fast 3.3 km (2.1 mi) loop around the business center on Columbia Gateway Drive. With a total elevation gain of 33 m (108 ft) each lap, the loop runs clockwise from the start at the intersection of Albert Einstein Drive. The course consists of sweeping right turns with a sharp 90° right turn at the 2 km (1.2 mi) mark at the end of a fast downhill section. A short climb into the finish straight will ensure excitement for both spectators and racers.

**Logistics:** Race-day registration opens at 7:00 AM and closes 30 min prior to posted start times. Pre-registration is encouraged. ACCC riders, use pre-reg code. One day USAC licenses available for \$15.

**Notes:** The inner lanes of Columbia Gateway Drive will be closed for the race and the centerline rule will be in effect. All USAC rules apply; each rider must present a valid USAC license (annual or one-day). Only Collegiate license holders and juniors in high school may participate in collegiate races. All riders must be wearing either collegiate or generic (no logo) kit.

Collegiate fields are open only to full-time collegiate students with valid USAC Collegiate licenses and full-time high school students with valid USAC Junior licenses. Juniors will only be allowed to participate in events for which they are qualified based on USAC Rule 6D1. Jerseys and bibs for all such riders must feature school names and/or logo, or be generic blank kits; non-scholastic club and trade team kits are not permitted. In addition, new non-collegiate women racers with 1-day or first time Category 4 licenses may enter Collegiate Women's C or D events. USA Cycling licenses will be available for purchase on-site.
