Directions

- Google/GPS to Snyder St, Wilkesboro, NC 28697 Go to <http://highcountrycx.com/directions> for maps and detailed instructions. From US-421 N take Exit 268A - NC 16/NC 18 exit. Turn Left at end of ramp Follow NC-16/NC-18 1 mile through Downtown Wilkesboro. Go Straight onto Old US-421 at light past Re-Store, at intersection with Oakwoods Rd (do not follow NC-16/NC-18). Follow Old US-421 about 1/2 mile to a bridge crossing Take Left after crossing bridge onto Snyder St into Wilkesboro Wastewater Treatment Plant Go straight up hill through white gate, past brick building on left. Turn Right on Tom's Roost, up steep gravel road. You may park in field adjacent to bath house on left OR continue up hill (steep gravel, be cautious of water bars) and park adjacent to registration and the finish at the top of the hill. OR go straight past Tom's Roost Turn Right past buildings Follow gravel road up hill to clearing on left, registration is on the right (this is further from the bathrooms, but close to registration)

Registration

- Collegiate registration and check-in will open at 7:15 am on Saturday. Collegiate racers should pre-register at accycling.org. Collegiate racers may register for a second non-collegiate race Saturday on site for \$10.
